

HI Wilderness Season Pass

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Wilderness Season Pass entitles the passholder to the following benefits:

- Season-long access (Nov 1, 2025 May 31, 2026) to HI Kananaskis, HI Castle Mountain, HI Mosquito Creek, HI Beauty Creek, HI Rampart Creek, and HI Nordegg on any dates the hostel is open and where availability exists. Nightly limits, blackout periods, and seasonal/weekday closures apply.
- 20% off member rate at HI Banff and HI Lake Louise—Sunday to Thursday inclusive.
- 20% off accommodation at select Alpine Club of Canada properties: HI Canmore (valid Sunday—Thursday nights only), Bow Hut, Jacques Lake Cabin, Fryatt Creek Hut, and Cameron Lake Hut. Please note: The Alpine Club of Canada is a separate association and maintains its own booking procedures, restrictions, and policies, which differ from HI Canada's terms. Discounts are subject to availability and ACC conditions.
- Includes a complimentary two-year Hostelling International Membership.
- PASS IS NOT VALID CHRISTMAS PERIOD (DEC 23 JAN 1 INCLUSIVE). <u>SEASONAL AND WEEKDAY</u> CLOSURES APPLY.
- This pass is not valid for accommodation of seasonal workers or individuals working in the area and is not intended to be used as housing.
- · Pass is valid for shared dorm room accommodation only.
- Pass is non-transferable, non-refundable and cannot be combined with any other offers.

Reservations

- · Reservations are required and subject to availability.
- Bookings and extensions can only be made through Central Reservations. Walk-ins and extensions cannot be made at the hostels.
- Reservations are accepted a maximum of three weeks prior to check-in.
- A credit card number is required at the time of reservation.
- The maximum consecutive length of stay at one HI Wilderness Hostel is 4 nights.
- The pass is valid for a maximum of 10 nights per calendar month per property.
- A piece of valid government-issued photo ID must be presented upon check-in each stay, matching the name of the passholder.

Cancellations

- For a booking made at any participating hostel with the Wilderness Season Pass: Your reservation may be cancelled up to 2 pm Mountain Time (MT) one day prior to your arrival without penalty.
- In the event of a late cancellation or non arrival, the credit card on file will be charged for the first night of the reservation.

USING YOUR SEASON PASS

Making a Reservation:

- Call 1.866.762.4122. Mention that you are a Wilderness Season Pass holder when reserving and be prepared to provide your pass number.
- A credit card is required to secure your booking but will only be charged in the event of a late cancellation or no-show. In this case, regular cancellation charges apply.
- For reservations with the Alpine Club of Canada properties, bookings must be made directly with the ACC (info@alpineclubofcanada.ca or 403-678-3200 ext. 0).

Check-in/Check-out Times at HI Canada Wilderness Hostels

- Please respect hostel check-in and check-out times. Check-in time is from 5pm to 9pm. Please do not arrive before or after these times. Check-out time is 10am.
- For security reasons, the hostel dorms and entire building may be locked between 10am and 5pm.
- For all other HI Canada hostels or Alpine Club of Canada properties, please refer to their respective websites for check-in and check-out times.

Checking In:

• Be sure to bring a piece of valid government-issued photo ID. You are required to present it upon check-in for each stay.

Sporting Equipment:

• Storage and maintenance of sporting equipment is permitted in designated areas of the hostel only. Please check with manager as to the location(s) of designated areas.

Friends of Registered Guests

• The hostel is for registered guests only. Your pass does not include guest access. Friends must register with the manager and pay the overnight rate. We do not provide a 'day use' fee, so even if your friend is only staying for a few hours in the evening, they will have to pay the full overnight rate.

During your stay:

- Wilderness hostels are a communal environment with limited space, equipment and staff. They are
 much closer to backcountry cabins in nature than they are to most of our larger hostels and are priced
 accordingly. As such, guests are expected to:
 - · Show respect to fellow guests and staff
 - Support other adventurers—Alpine days start early!
 - Keep their belongings tidy and compact
 - · Clean up after themselves
 - Use appropriate language and behavior, as these are family-friendly spaces
- Please help keep everyone's stay enjoyable by abiding by this code of conduct. Failure to do so may result in the suspension or cancellation of the Wilderness Season Pass at the hostel manager's discretion, in which case no refunds will be issued.
